Rhubarb & Ginger Gin, Fresh Lime, Ginger Ale, Over Ice

Pedro Ximinez Emilio Hidalgo Sherry, 50ml 5.5

Fizz 125ml Bottle

Prosecco, Pasqua, Treviso, Italy 5.5 25  
*Youthful, gently floral, peach, pear and tropical notes. Refreshing and easy going from the home of Prosecco.*

Sparkling Shiraz, The Tight Cluster, 2012, Australia 35  
*Lovely deep colour with berry fruits, spice, hints of cedar, some subtle smoky notes and liquorice. With a fine mousse, the wine has some lovely bright and more aged shiraz characters on the palate. Nice primary fruit with some spice and subtle oak. The fortified shiraz – albeit a very small component – has tightened and freshened the wine up really well.*

Champagne, Lallier, N/V, Grand Cru Brut, France 48  
*A champagne of exhilarating freshness, complexity and finesse, the flagship blend of lallier. The energising citrusy palate delivers an equal measure of ripe, tasty fruit followed by a tasty, elegant finish.*

Rose Champagne, Grand Cru Rose, Lallier, France 55  
*Its pale pink colour wheedles our senses. With its enchanting aromas of wild strawberry and raspberry, spiced up with citrus notes, are a delight for our nose. The lead is clear and precise; its freshness then mingles with sensual and gourmet notes of wild strawberry.*

## White

175ml 250ml Bottle

**Catarratto, Terra Firma, 2015, Sicily, Italy** 5 6.5 19.5

*Catarratto is a bright, zesty white with delicate, peachy fruit. It does everything that Pinot Grigio can do but with considerably more charisma. Easy and fresh drinking. Great as an aperitif.*

**Verdejo, Diez Siglos Verdejo Rueda, Spain** 6 7.5 24

*This bright and pure Verdejo has aromas of Stone fruit & citrus, peachy and apricot notes too! It's simply, a lovely wine, easy drinking, superb with a little selection of small plates or excellent with fish!*

**Pinot Gris, Sileni, 2016,  
Hawkes Bay, New Zealand** 6 7.5 24

*Ripe, Juicy Stone Fruit, bit of pear, a bit of citrus, well balanced, good with fish!*

**Sauvignon Blanc, Berry Bros. & Rudd, 2016  
New Zealand** 6 7.5 25

*Full of fresh gooseberries, hints of tomato leaf and passion fruit, there is nonetheless an elegant restraint here. The typical Marlborough pungency is held in check by tangy citrus notes and a fine, mineral finish. This is a delicious wine with verve and vibrancy.*

**Riesling, Kung Fu Girl,  
Washington State, 2016, USA** 34

*It takes an unconventional winemaker to make a totally unexpected dry Riesling. One night, Charles was eating Chinese takeout and watching a fight scene in a notorious martial arts film when he had an idea: a killer white wine made to be paired with Asian food. Just like that, Kung Fu Girl was born. And it's been kicking ass and taking names ever since.*

**Rosé** 175ml 250ml Bottle

**Pink Orchid Zinfandel Rose, USA** 5.5 7 20

*Delicate pink in colour, fabulous aromatic intensity.*

*Strawberries, yet medium sweetness.*

**Provence Rose, Le Vielle Tour, France** 6.5 8 25.5

*This gloriously kwoffable wine is delicate, with lovely sweet fruit from Grenache grapes. Ripe Berries, fresh & fruity.*

**Red** 175ml 250ml Bottle

**Merlot, Tulbagh, 2016, South Africa** 5 6.5 20

*Full bodied greatness from SA! Smooth, well balanced.*

*Easy drinking, fab mid week glugger! Also great value.*

**Primitivo, Ill Puma, Italy** 6 7.5 24

*Deep ruby red with violet reflections; intense aroma,*

*with notes of plum and cherry, spicy, with rosemary and vanilla scents.*

*A full-bodied wine, soft and balanced, easy to drink.*

**Malbec, Alpataco, 2016, Argentina** 6.5 8 26

*Intense, complex nose with a combination of red fruits such as cherries*

*and a hint of violets. Smooth mouth feel, this is a fresh and fruit wine*

*that carries vanilla and caramel notes from ageing in small oak barrels.*

*A well defined structure and drinking beautifully now.*

**Rioja, Reserva, Ramon Bilbao, 2011, Spain** 7 8.5 30

*Amazing! Sumptuous and classical in style with good use of American oak*

*aromas of blackberries, cedar, leather and spices. Good balance on the palate with a long finish.*

**Côtes-du-Rhône, Château Courac 2015** 30

*Generous and rich in the 2015 vintage, this is a full-bodied fruity Rhône red from the village of Laudun. Syrah plays a significant part in the blend, hence the deep colour and dark spicy fruit.*
